According to 8 C.F.R 214.2 (f) (7) (i), "an F-1 student who is currently maintaining status and making normal progress toward completing his or her educational objective, but who is unable to complete his or her course of study by the program end date on the Form I-20, must apply prior to the program end date for a program extension...."

- the program end date on your I-20 has not yet been reached
- you have continually maintained legal status
- the delay in completion is caused by compelling academic or medical reasons, such as change of major or documented illness
